

Draft Eurogroup annotated agenda¹ 15 September 2017

Starting time 10h00, Tallinn

1. Economic resilience in EMU – Thematic discussions on growth and jobs

The Eurogroup will hold an exchange of views on the concept of economic resilience in the EMU and the areas in which more could be done to achieve more resilient economic structures within the euro area. This discussion is expected to frame future thematic discussions of the Eurogroup on growth and jobs.

The concept of economic resilience has recently been discussed in international fora, such as the G20 and the OECD. In Europe, it was first brought forward by the Five Presidents' report in 2015, which stated that convergence towards more resilient economic and social structures in Member States is an essential element for the successful performance of EMU in the long run.

2. Greece – State of play

Ministers will be informed by the institutions and Greece on progress in programme implementation as well as on the planning for the third review.

At its meeting in June, the Eurogroup finalised the discussions on the second review of the ESM programme, which paved the way for the approval by the ESM governing bodies of the disbursement of the third tranche of the ESM programme amounting to a total of EUR 8.5 bn.
